

# The Point Magazine Submission Guidelines

## Writing

**Pitches Only**--Please do not submit full-length articles, we only accept ideas for articles. This way we can choose stories that work best with the magazine and be a part of the writing process. This also saves you a lot of wasted effort.

**Nothing Offensive, Defamatory, or Crude**-- Please use your best judgment with this and remember who your audience is.

**AP Style**-- No first person unless cleared by the web editor, no "you/your." This is a news publication, not a diary.

**No Word Count**-- Be prepared for the web editor to ask you to expand or cut down. Word count will depend on subject matter.

## Photos

**Nothing Offensive, Defamatory, or Crude**-- Please use your best judgment with this and remember who your audience is.

**Must be a Series**--For the sake of organization, we only accept photo series with a 3-photo minimum. If you send multiple photos to us we will find a way to place them together in a single series.

**Each Photo MUST .JPEG Files Less Than ONE Megabyte**--The picture should be about 900x600 pixels and if you are using Photoshop please use the save for web option (72ppi).

**Title and Description Required for Each Photo**-- To preserve the journalistic integrity of the website, we require a title for your series of photos and each photo. A description for your series and each photo is required as well.
